WHAT IS RSPO & WHO ARE INVOLVED?

- An association created by organization carrying out activities related to supply chain of palm oil.
- Pioneer member: Golden Hope Plantations Berhad, Migros, MPOA, Sainsbury's, Aarhus United UK Ltd., Unilever & WWF.
- The aim is to bring together community working on palm oil to discuss and to cooperate towards promoting the growth & use of sustainable palm oil

WHAT IS RSPO & WHO ARE INVOLVED?

- RSPO was formally established on 8th April 2004.
- Members of RSPO – growers, processors/traders, consumer goods manufacturers, banks/investor, environmental/nature conservation NGOs & social/development NGOs and affiliate member.
- By joining RSPO, organization publicly communicate their commitment to SPO production and use.

CURRENT SCENARIO

As of October 2009:

- 11 organization certified
- 23 announcement of main assessments

Challenges:

- Acceptance of CSPO
- Promotion of CSPO
- Capacity Building



CURRENT SCENARIO

Latest development:

- P,C & I (working group on GHG, HCV & Biodiversity, Integrated Weeds Management, Dispute Settlement)
- Certification system document (clause 4.2.4 and its effect)
- Group certification for Small holders
- Financial (bankers/investors/insurers) verification

WHAT'S NEXT

- Ongoing development of the P&C, supply chain, smallholders task force etc.
- Bio fuel requirement
(Food vs. Fuel, RSB, ISCC, Countries Bio Fuel Policy: EU (RED), Malaysia/Indonesia)
- Promotion of CSPO usage : China & along the supply chain.
